Many lies about the Bible

- 1. Lie "It's too confusing and/or difficult to understand"
- 2. Lie "So many people have different views the true meaning is not knowable"
- 3. The Bible is anti-science
- 4. The Bible is oppressive (slavery/misogynistic)
- 5. It's too old to apply to current culture
- The majority of people who leave the church can't <u>articulate</u> their faith
- 87% of American households own a Bible
- 13% of American's have read the entire Bible
- Developing a Biblical Worldview involves looking at the world through the <u>perspective</u> of the Biblical lens.
- Scripture shapes our paradigm, external worldviews don't shape Scripture
