Key Words in Genesis 1:

- 1. God <u>Created.</u>
- 2. God Spoke.
- 3. God <u>Saw.</u>

Design assumes a Designer.

3 Areas that Prove there was a Creator:

1. Cosmology – study of the <u>origin</u> of the universe.

The KALAM Argument for the Existence of God.

- (1) Whatever begins to exist has a <u>cause</u>.
- (2) The universe began to exist. Therefore it must have a <u>cause.</u>

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- (3) If the universe has a cause, the Creator must be <u>eternal</u>, have a <u>will</u>, and be <u>personal</u>.
- Physics the numbers that govern the universe <u>conspire</u> to make life possible.
 Key Point: there is <u>no chance</u> that life could randomly exist.
- DNA the <u>chemical instructions</u> in the cells of the human body.
 Key Point: nature cannot produce <u>information</u>. Only <u>intelligence</u> can produce information.

The Bible AND Science point towards a Creator, not away from one.
