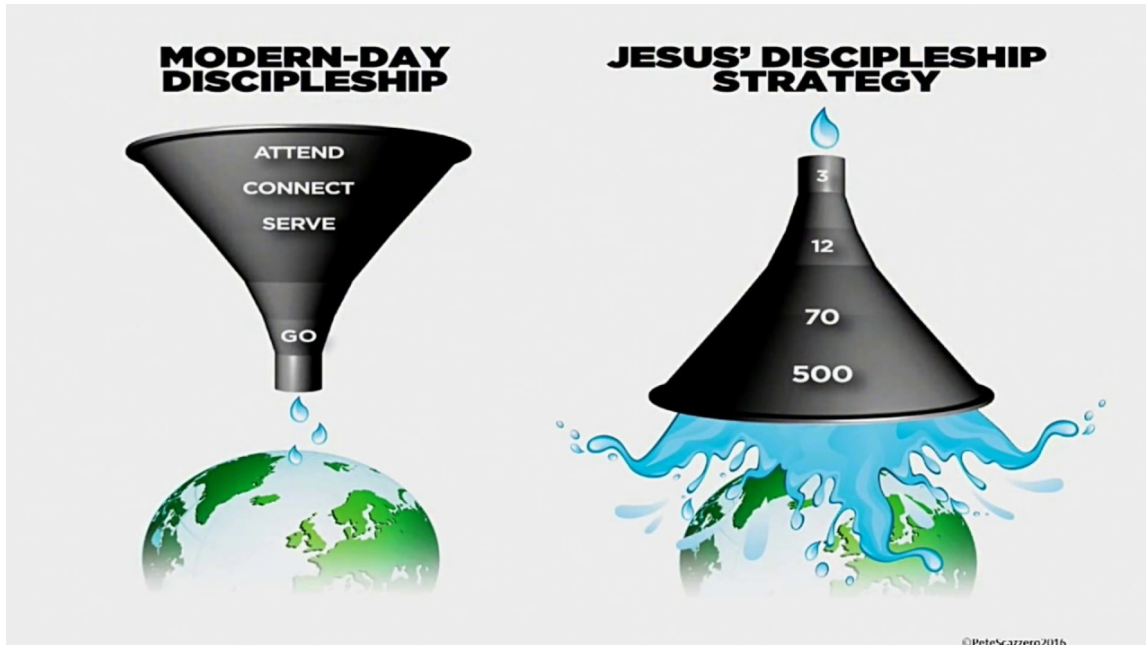


FIVE DISCIPLE-MAKING TIPS

Acts 2:42



How do you “do discipleship”? Follow the model laid out for us in Acts 2:42 which says, “They devoted themselves to the apostles’ teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.”

5 Tips to Being an Effective Disciple-Maker

1. **Devotion** - “They devoted themselves”
2. **Scripture-Centered** - The Bible is our anchor for teaching
3. **Fellowship** - Hanging out together
4. **Eat Together Meaningfully** - “to the breaking of bread”
5. **Pray Together** - “to prayer”
 - a. Spiritual community is HUGE in a distracted and disengaged world
 - b. Have a way - text, GroupMe, email, smoke signals - of communicating prayer needs with one another, and as the leader. follow up!
 - c. Actually PRAY with and for them - Not just, “I’m praying for you,” but DO IT.

Don’t over-complicate discipleship. You can do this!
