
When I Wake Up

My favorite place to pray is:


3. Plan




Connect with God. He is your loving Father.

Pray for what He wants (pray His agenda first).



Ask God for what you want and need, and then trust Him to provide for you.







Ask God to lead you every day.



The Armor of God

Read Ephesians 6:11-18 and then say a prayer to God like the one on the next page to put on your armor!

"Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. Therefore, put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground. and after you have done everything, to stand. Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God. And prav in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people." **EPHESIANS 6:11-18**


Praying Through the Armor of God

2. The Covering of the Blood of Jesus

When Jesus died on the cross for us, His precious blood was shed. His blood saves us, washes our sin away, and protects us. *Eph. 1:7*

3. The Word Of God (The Bible)

The Bible is full of prayers of protection. It is such a powerful weapon against the enemy. We can pray God's Word over us and our family. Psalm 91 is one of those great prayers of protection.

I pray that You will cover me with the protection of Your blood and surround me with Your angels.
